Setting up email notifications for the Paramont Series with Gmail

This guide will be utilizing the web GUI, the only difference between here and the local monitor will be accessing settings (ON LOCAL MONITOR TO ACCESS SETTINGS GO TO CIRCLE WITH FOUR SQUARES IN BOTTOM LEFT THIS IS YOUR START BUTTON CLICK SETTINGS, THIS WILL GIVE YOU SAME OPTIONS AS FUNCTION PANEL IN THIS GUIDE)

2. Input your SMTP Information **Our email notifications system has been tested with Gmail and Yahoo so that is InVid's recommendation. Outlook does work, it requires port 587 and TLS, but you will need to ensure no firewall or security settings are blocking the sending, InVid Tech cannot troubleshoot.
